Radon is a class-A human carcinogen so dangerous that the Surgeon General issued a warning similar to the warning label placed on cigarette packs. Most Americans are generally aware of the danger cigarettes pose but they are unaware of the deadly link between radon and lung cancer.

THE EPA ESTIMATES THAT RADON CAUSES OVER 21,000 CANCER DEATHS A YEAR.

Radon is a naturally occurring radioactive gas that is the by-product of the decay of uranium found in rocks and soils. As radon gas escapes from the ground it is emitted into homes. It enters homes through cracks in ground floors and can accumulate to dangerously high levels. Breathing in radon over time can lead to lung cancer.
