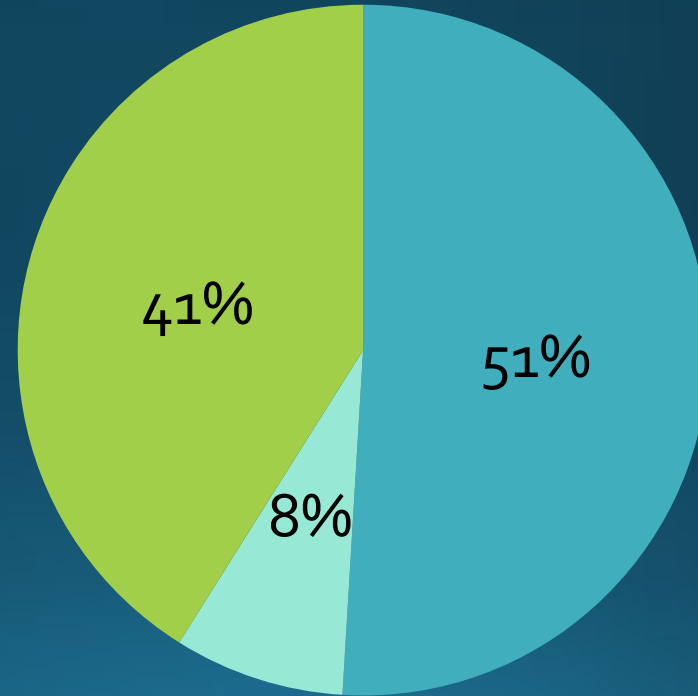

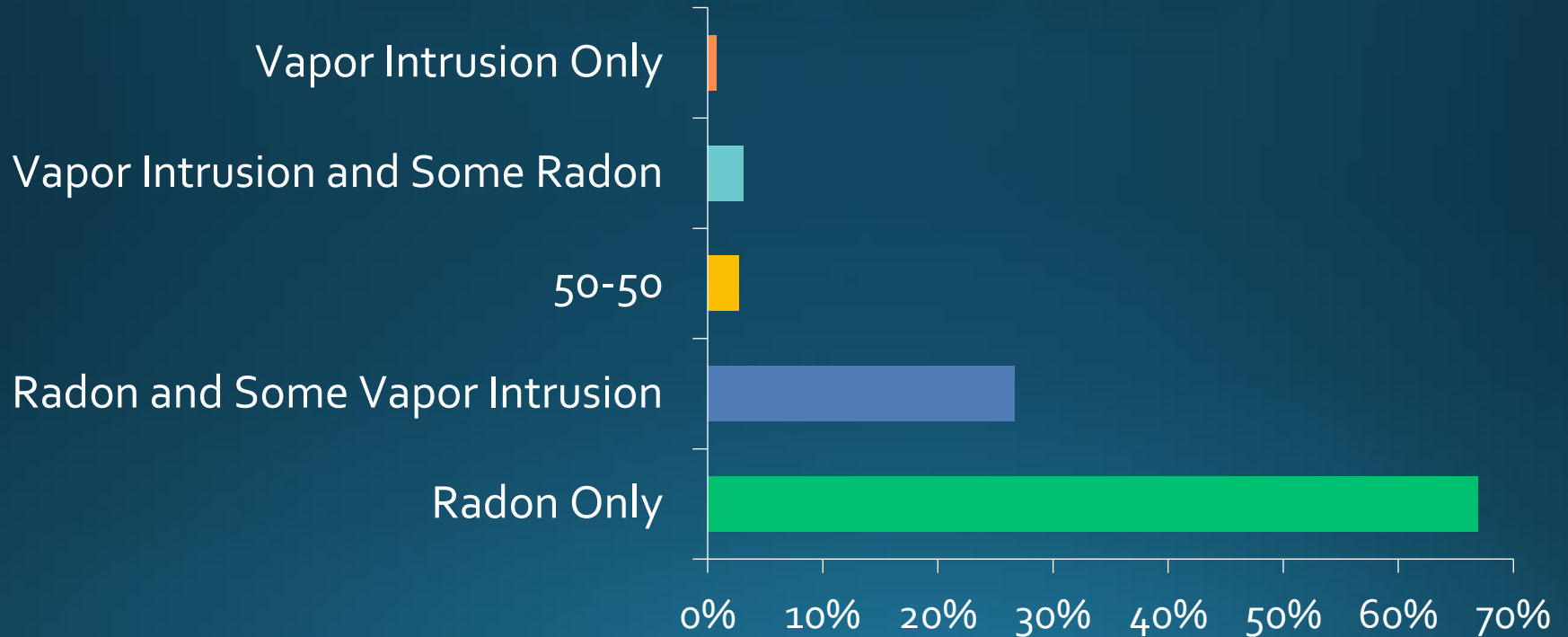

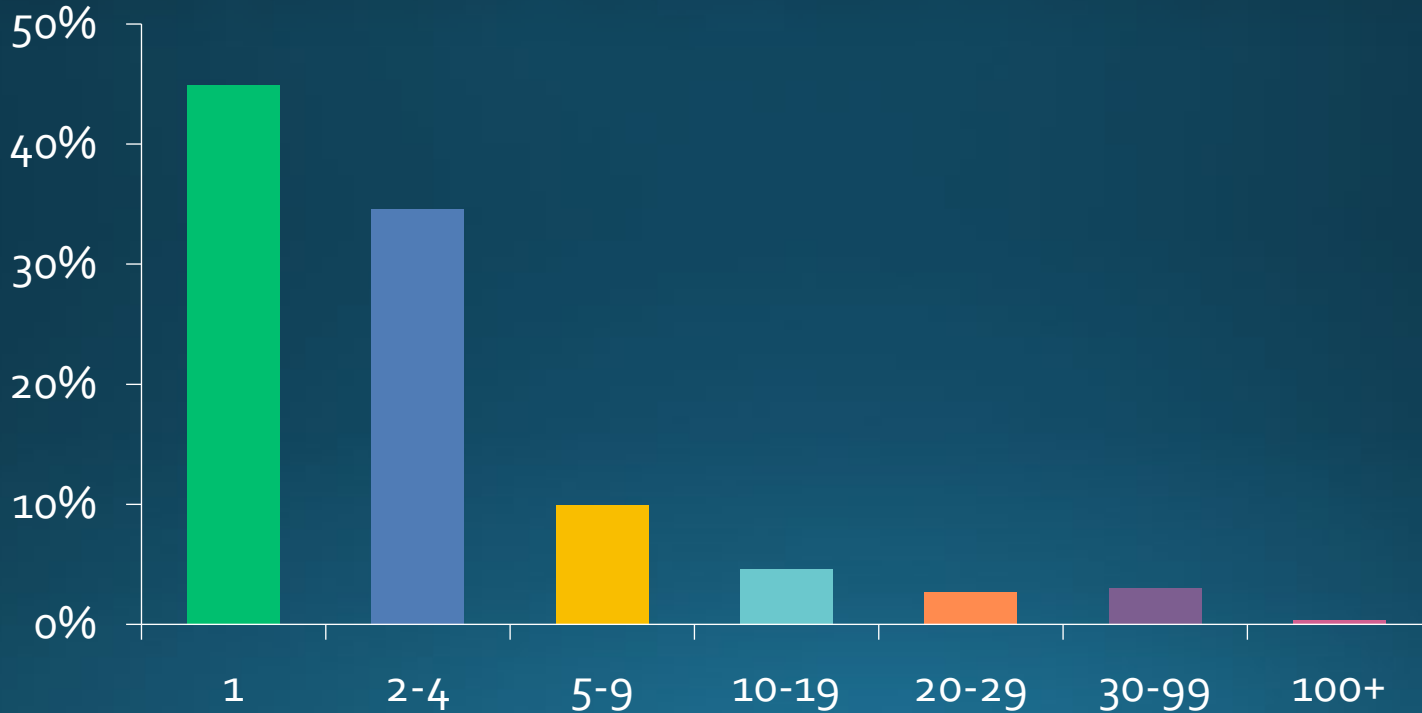

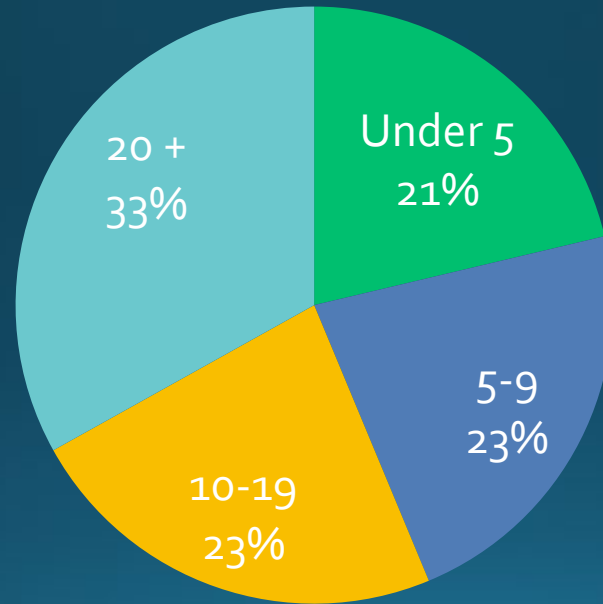
# Type of Soil Gas Work

# Longevity: Number of Years in Business

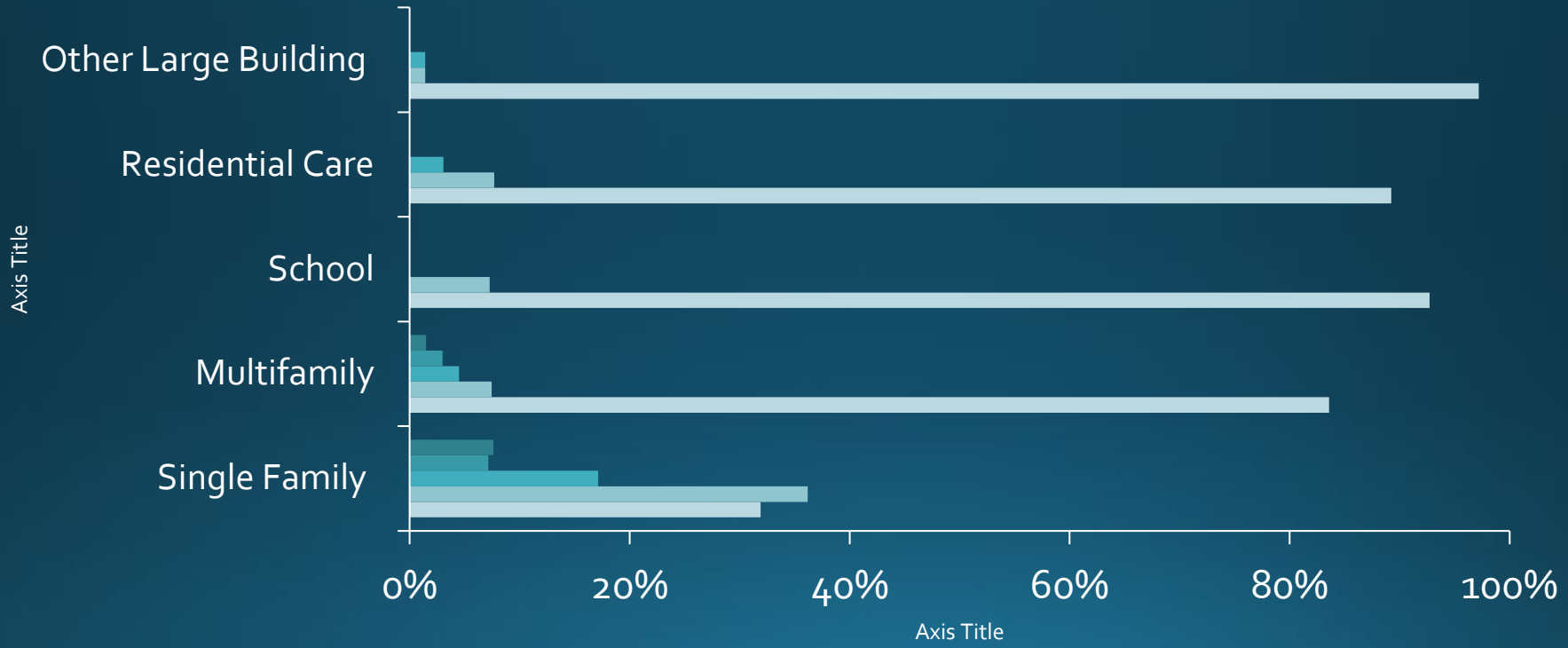

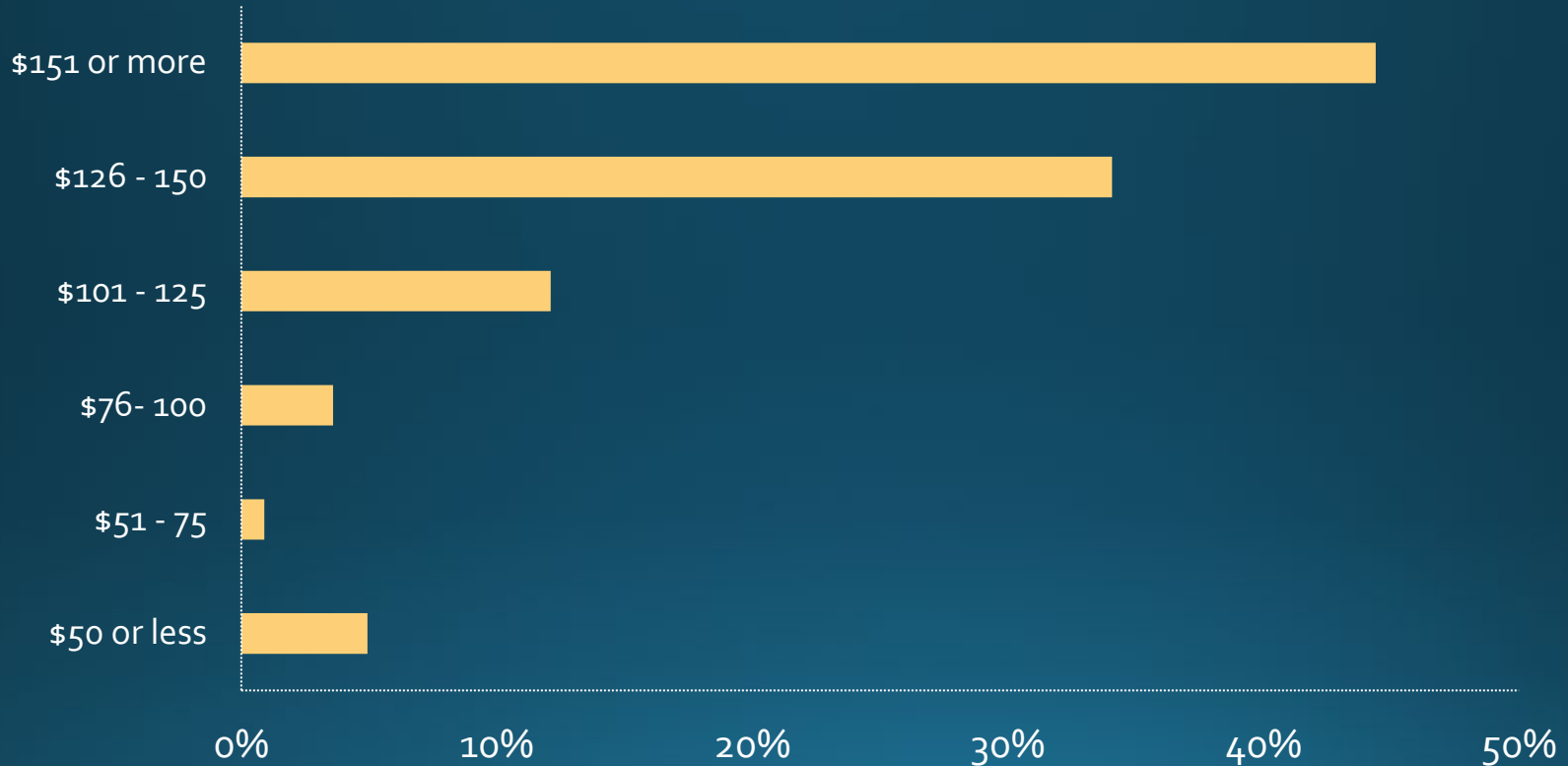

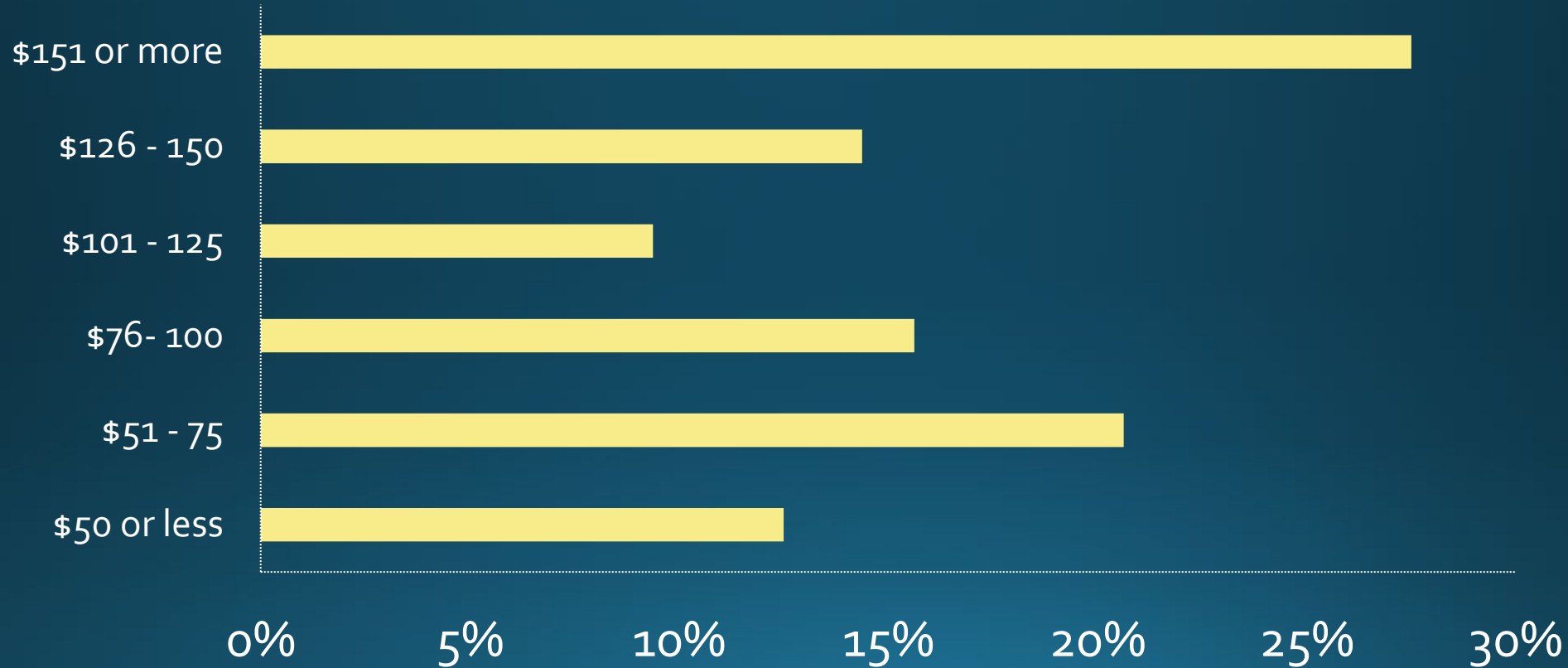

# Typical Measurement Cost - Single Family

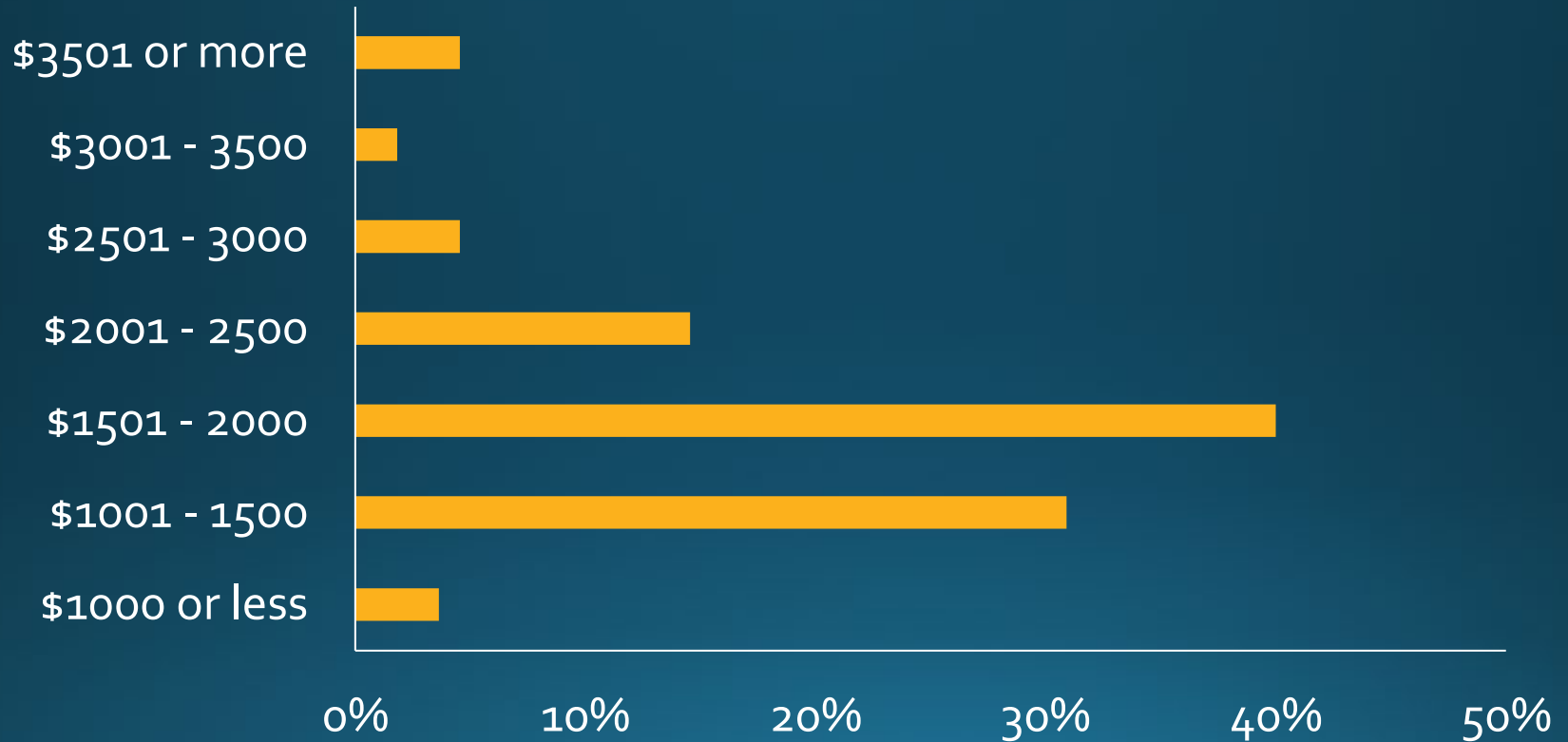


# Typical Measurement Cost - Multifamily per Unit

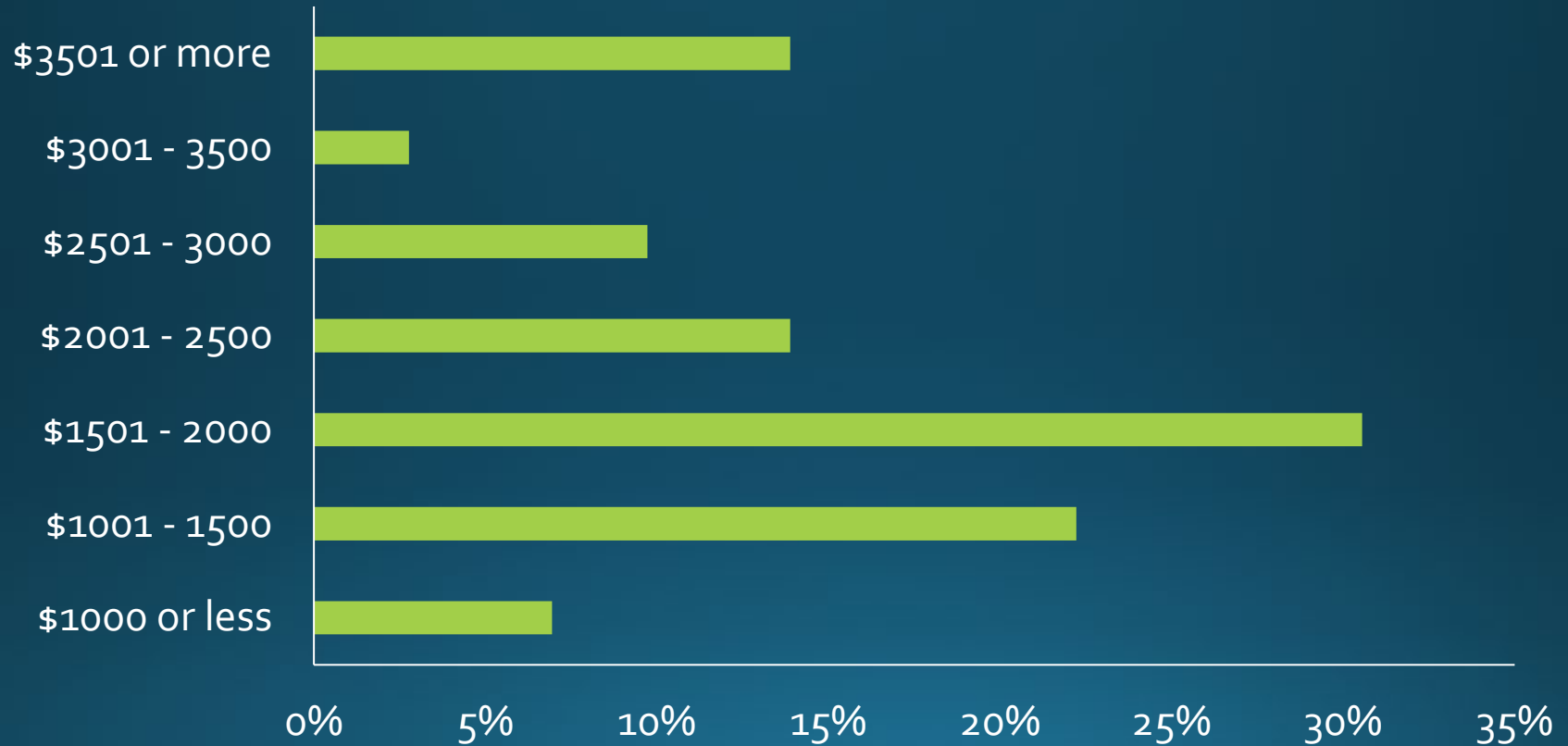

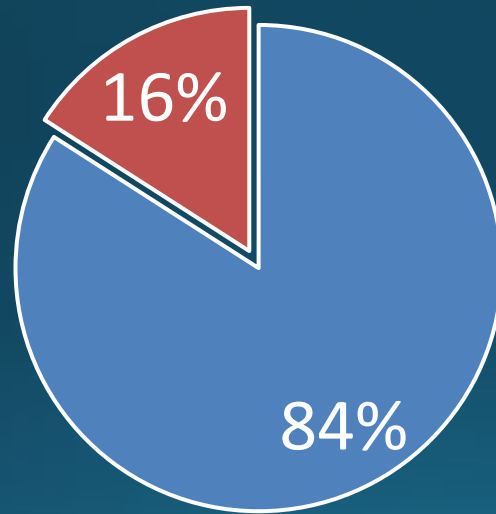
# Typical Mitigation Cost - Single Family

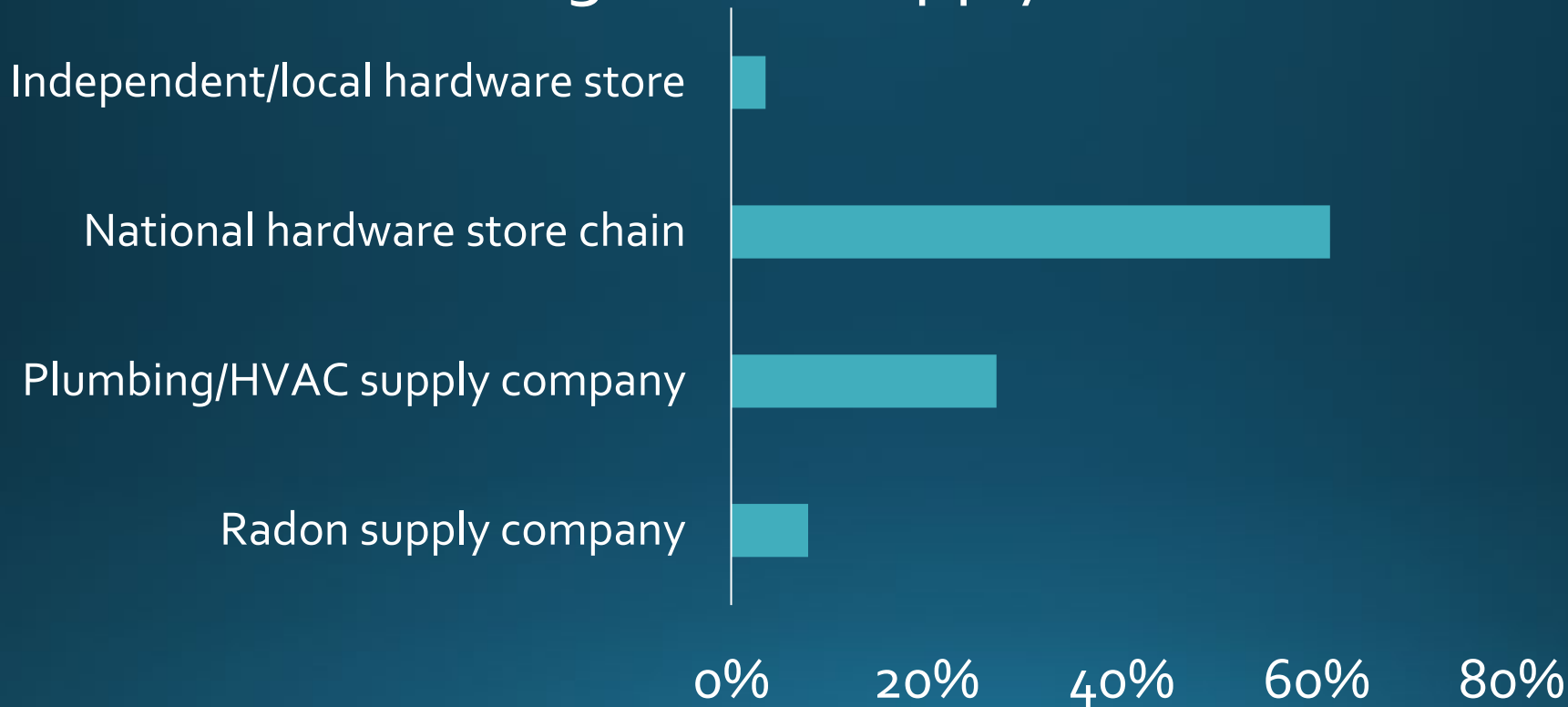

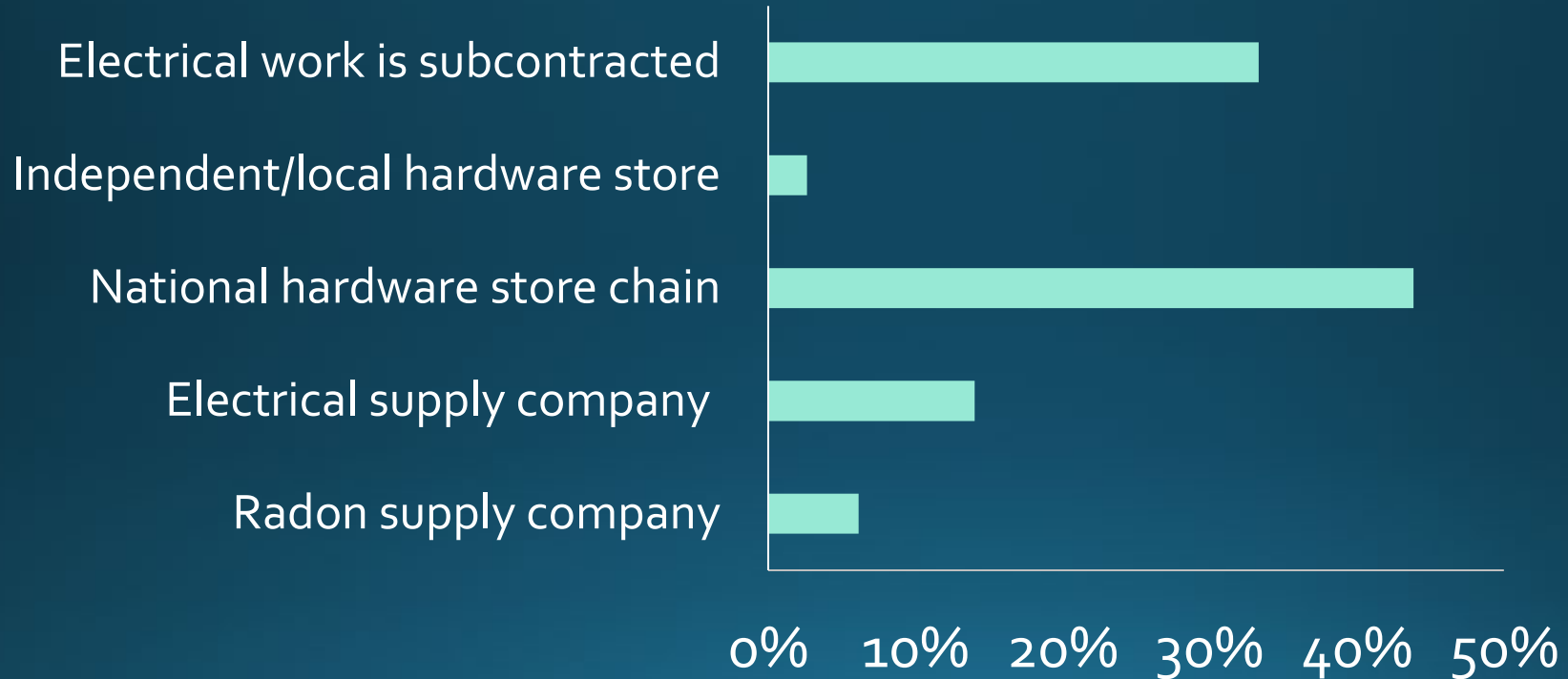

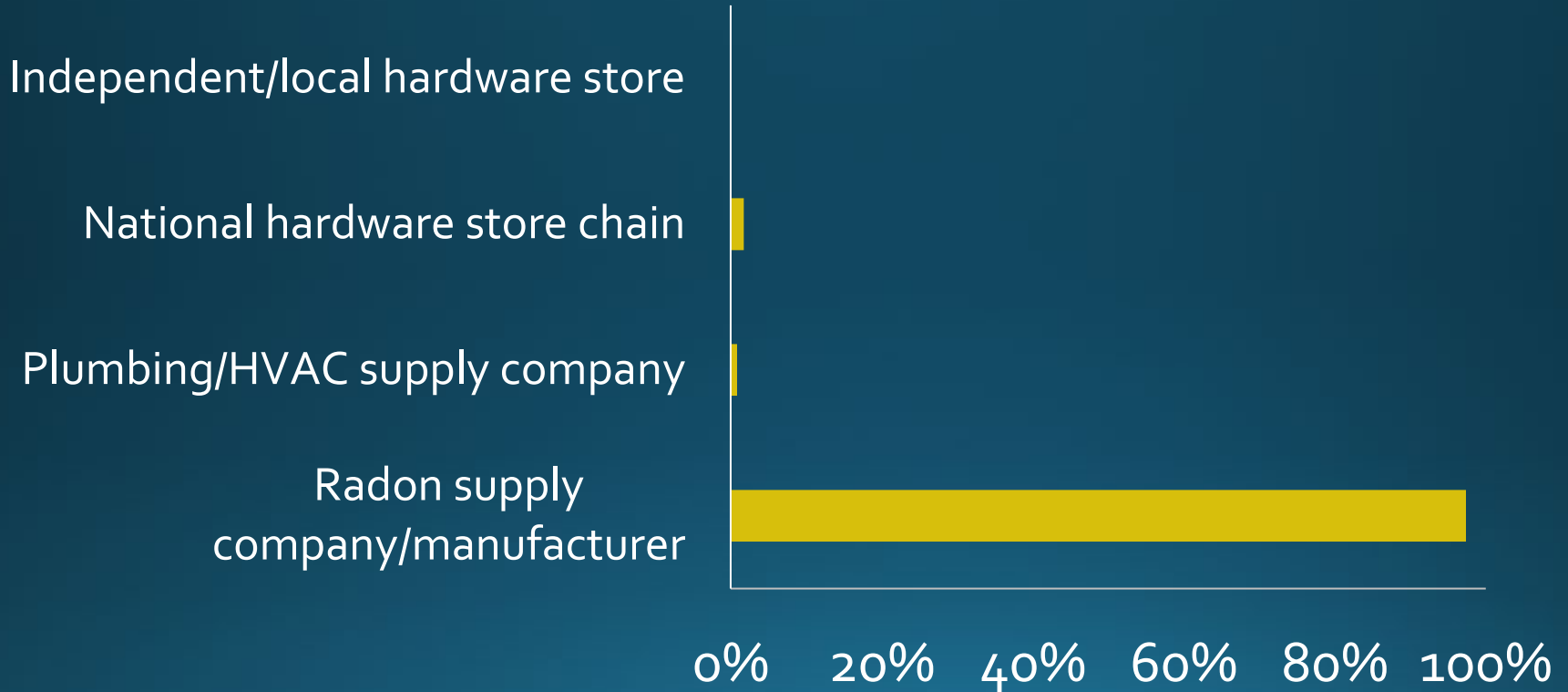
# Plumbing/HVAC Supply Source



# Electrical Supply Source

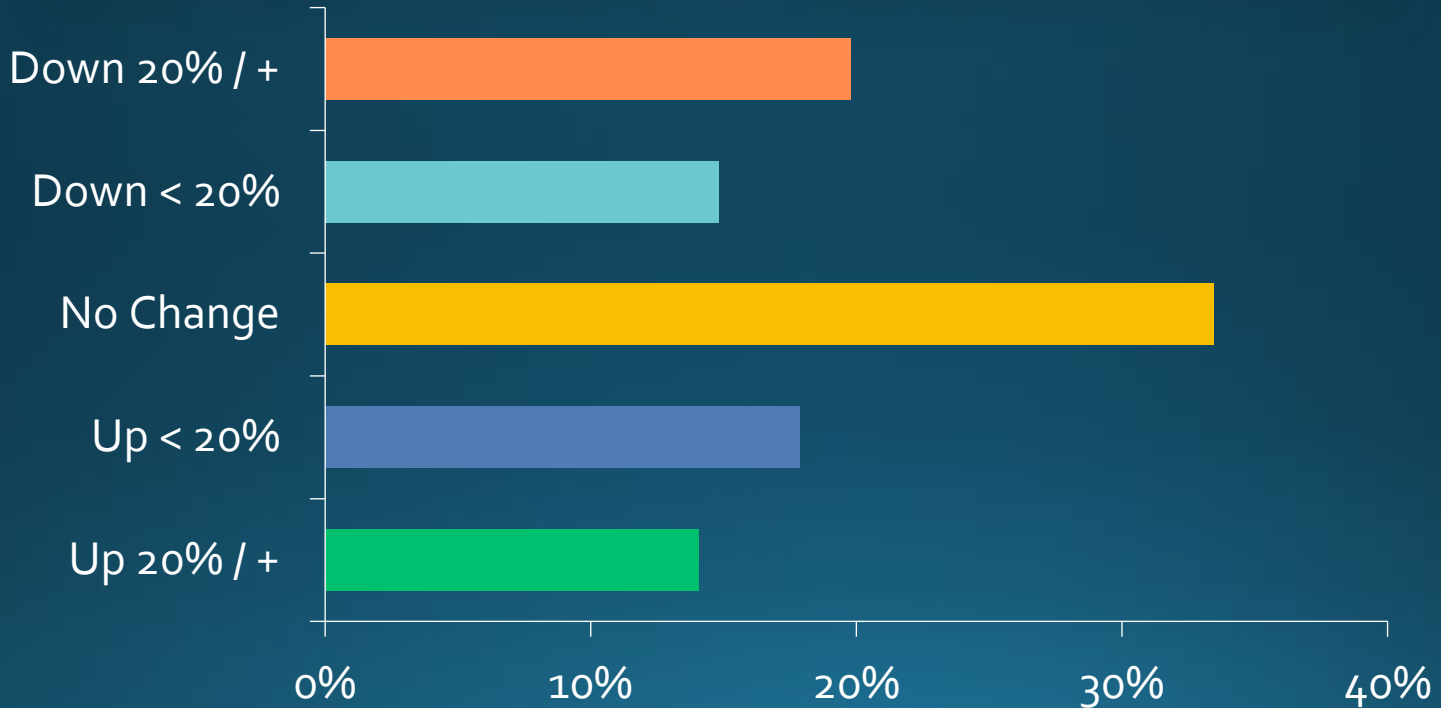


# Radon-Specific Supply Source

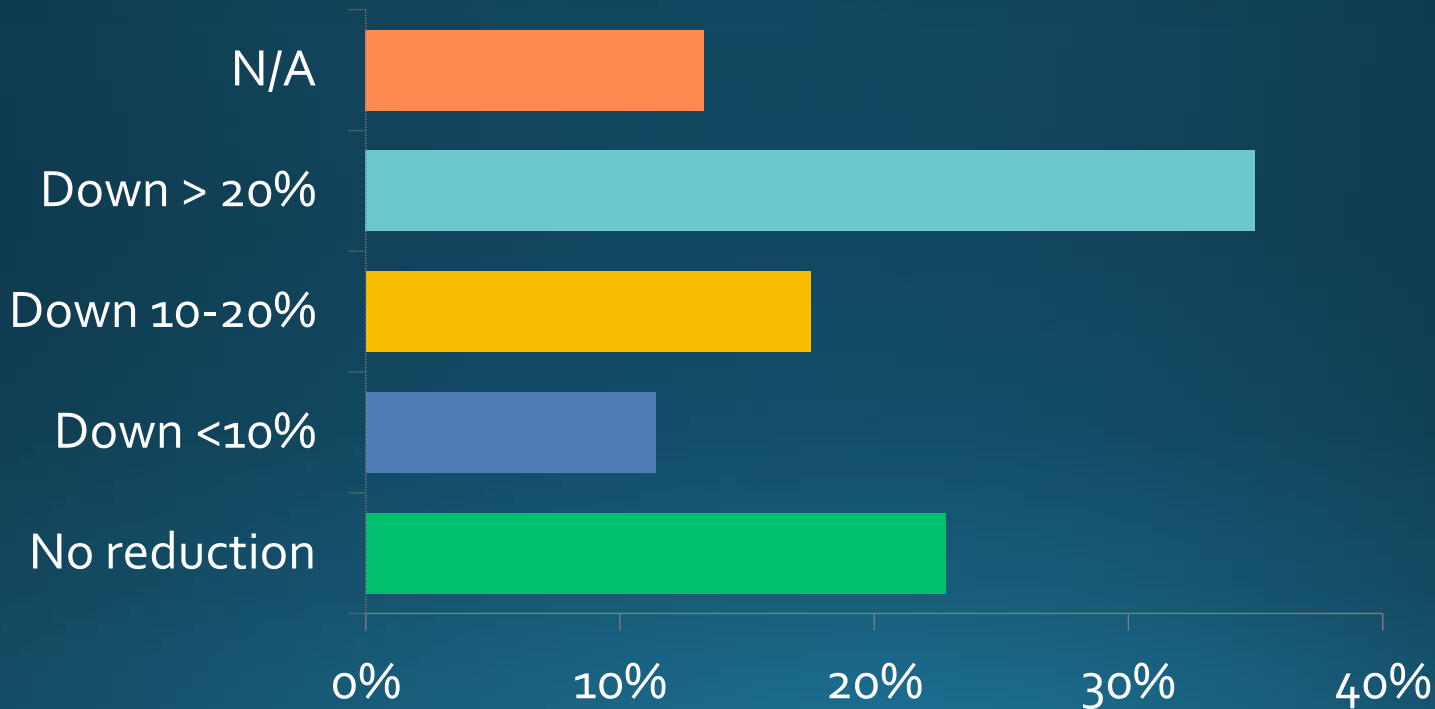

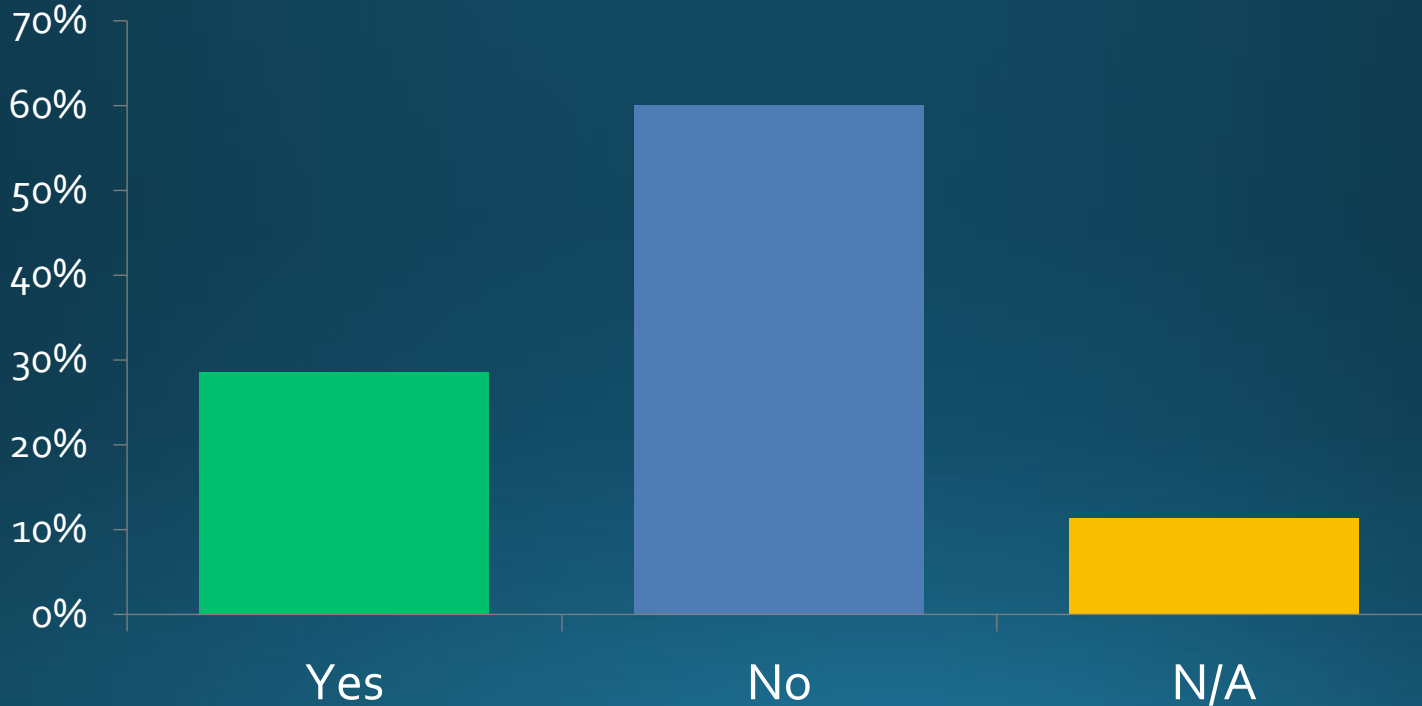
# Change in Work Volume Since COVID
