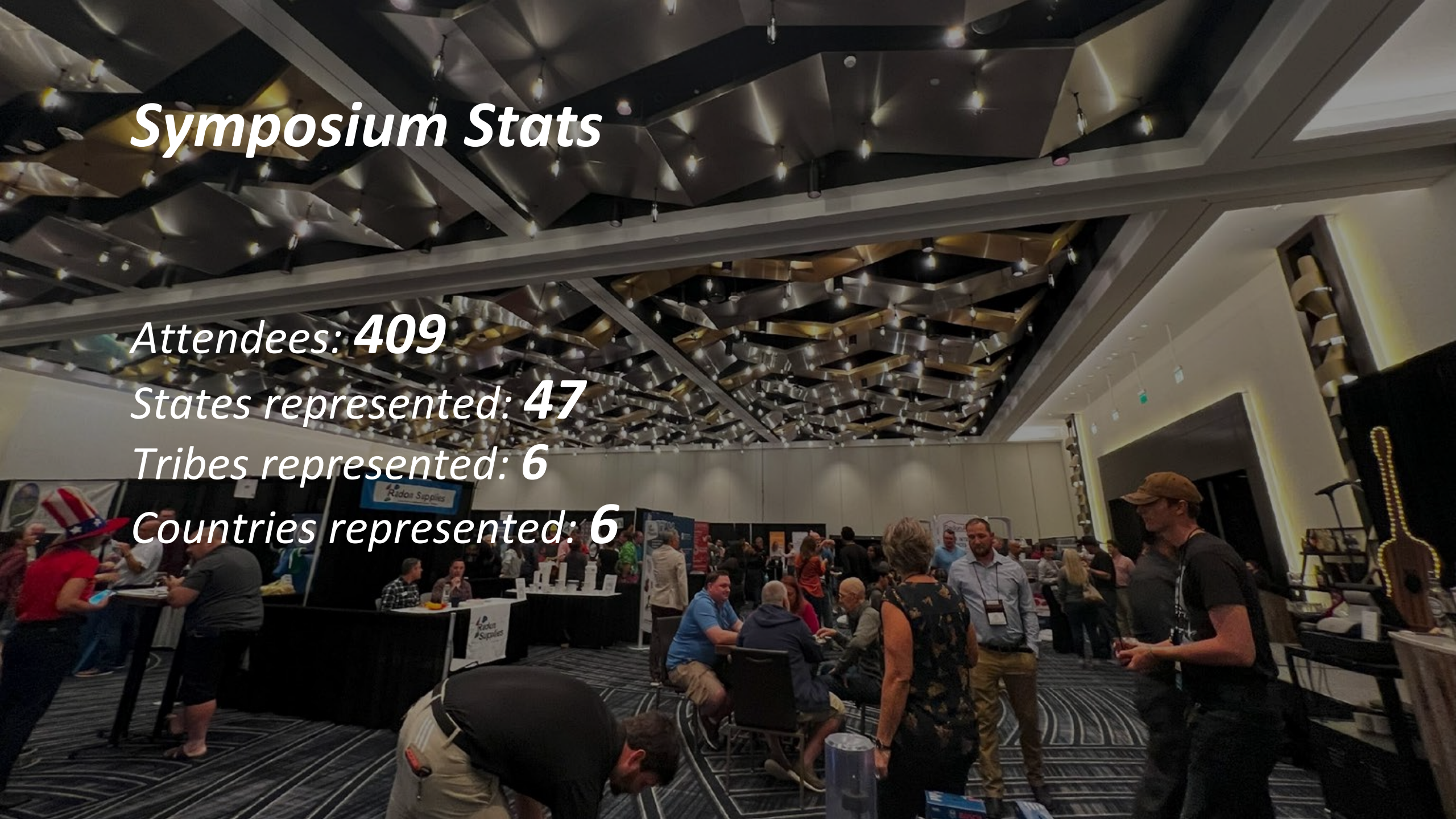

The Evolution of Lending Libraries in Canada

As of 2023, over 500 Canadian public libraries lend digital radon monitors

- Began in Nova Scotia in 2014, now in all provinces
- The majority lend AirThings Quantum Home devices due to easy digital display and privacy
- Pamphlets and instructions included in "kits" and kept up-to-date

Lending Kits- push to synchronize resources across the country

- Lended for 4 weeks (preparation)
- Devices taken out of circulation May-August and repaired, batteries replaced
- No patron information collected - ethical principles of libraries requested

How to fund radon library lending programs?

- Currently, primarily supported by Health Canada
- Have applied for competitive grants for STEM programming with libraries
- Also: Some started by personal donations and corporate sponsors

Problem- Wait lists are common - up to 2 years in some cases

- New initiative- programs for alpha track detectors for wall bases
- Address ethical issues of waiting too long

Positive- Innovation is occurring

- Programs started outside public libraries
- Career centers libraries
- Public school libraries
- Community non-profits in BC, Alberta, Health, Saskatchewan

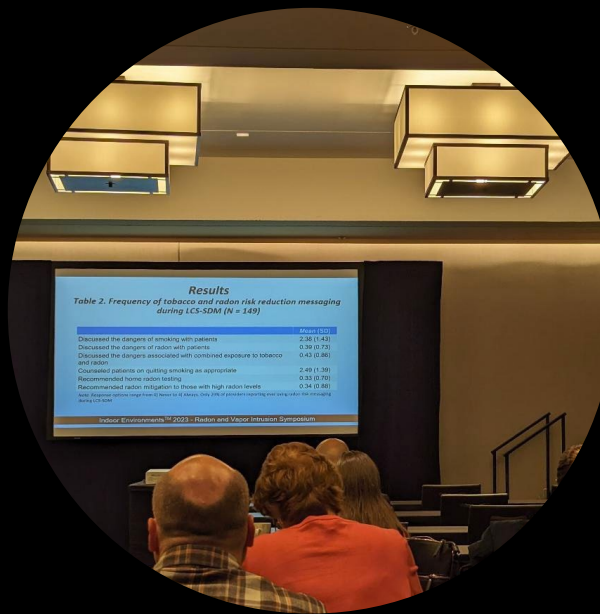

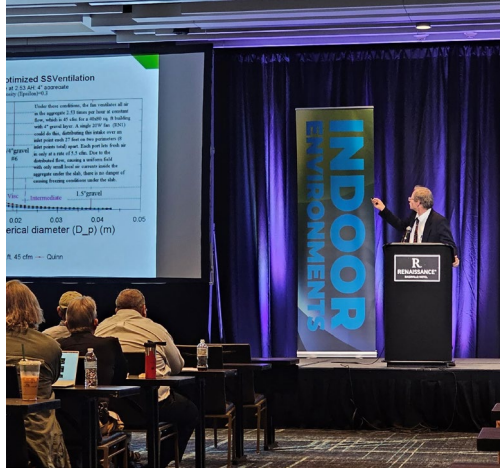


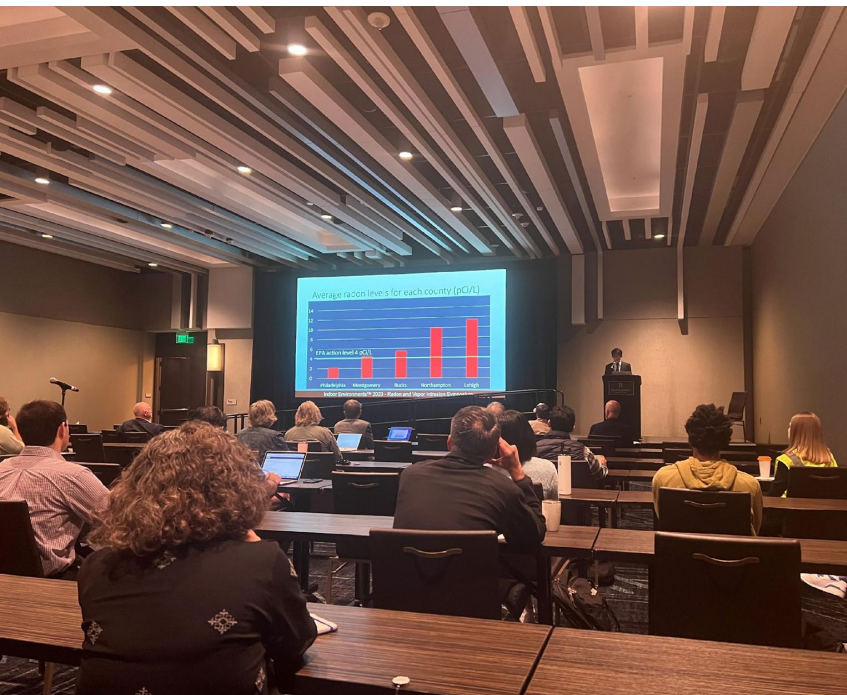
