We have performed over 175 audits in Indiana and Michigan in the last 3 years.

We have performed over 175 audits in Indiana and Michigan in the last 3 years.

(with another 100 to complete before the end of 2024)

We perform audits using the IEA Mitigation Audit App, which is essentially a checklist with photos.

We understand that *homeowners* sometimes alter their system between the time it was installed and the audit.

Audits were scheduled by sending out letters to homeowners with recently installed mitigation systems.

Locations were accepted on a first come first serve basis.

Roughly $\frac{2}{3}$ of the audits were performed in Indiana, a state requiring credentials, and $\frac{1}{3}$ were performed in Michigan, a state not requiring credentials.


