AND....lots and lots of opinions.



There are 3 Reasons Failures Usually Occur:

- 1. Simply because neither the client nor the measurement provider knows what the client needs.
- 2. The person conducting the measurement lacks the information or the competency to conduct a compliant measurement or compose a compliant report.

3. Communication Breakdown



- 1) Failures because neither the client nor the measurement provider knows what the client needs.
 - > Extraordinary Amount of Time Educating Clients
 - > Measurement Provider SHOULD know:
 - State Requirements (if any)
 - ANSI/AARST Requirements
 - MA-MFLB 2023
 - Or in some instances, MAMF 2017 rev.1/21



2) The person conducting the measurement lacks the information or the competency to conduct a compliant measurement or compose a compliant report.

- > Gathering pertinent information can be difficult.
- > Clients can be evasive with information.



"Sorry, we don't have much information about the building, but we need a quote TODAY!"





The person conducting the measurement is responsible for:

- ✓ Implementing a MFLB compliant testing plan
- **✓** Onsite Documentation
- Chain of Custody Documentation
- Report Preparation
- ✓ Assuring MFLB Compliance






- Knowing State Requirements (if any)
- Knowing ANSI accepted standards
 - MA-MFLB 2023
- When armed with necessary information, the measurement specialist must be able to decipher what the client needs.



3) Communication Breakdown
