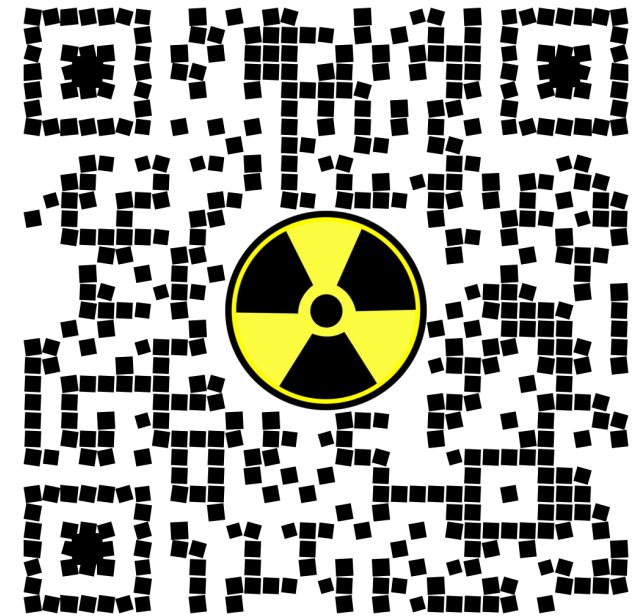


PYA Roundtable Discussion

- Alisha Keshwani is a junior at the University of Michigan studying Biology, Health, and Society and Science, Technology, and Society with a concentration in Medicine



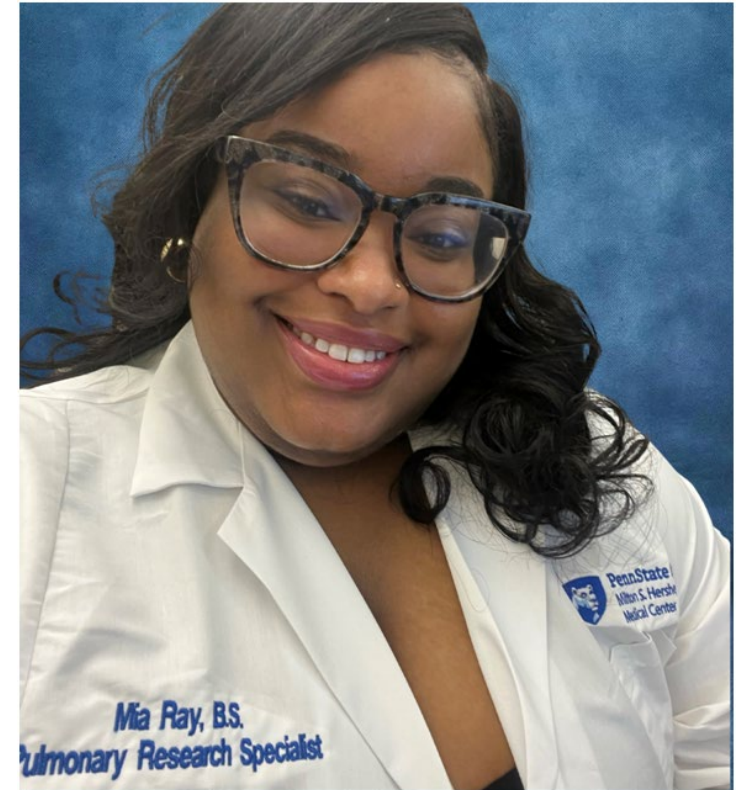
Alina Keshwani
